This event is held under the general competition rules of the MCUI (UC) Ltd, these regulations and the UC supplementary regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1- The trial will be held over a number of laps of a circuit. On each lap the competitor will be required to negotiate a number of observed sections, the number of laps and sections will be announced at the start. **The time limit will be 5hrs + ½ hr at one mark per minute loss then exclusion. This event will be ran as "NON STOP" and will be observed accordingly.**
 - 2- The onus on following the correct course lies with the competitor and all sections must be attempted in the correct order with punchcards punched by the observer of the section.
 - 3- No practising, either on or before the day of the event will be permitted. Anyone found breaking this rule would be excluded.
 - 4- All competitors must be in possession of a current competition licence issued by MCUI, ACU or SACU, which must be available for inspection. The promoters require holders of ACU and SACU competition licences to show evidence of the required Medical Expenses and Repatriation cover before permitting a start. If current licence cannot be produced then a one-day licence must be purchased.
 - 5- Helmets as per MCUI regulations must be worn by all competitors.
 - 6- Ties are decided on observation first and thereafter on number of cleans, ones etc.
 - 7- A separate area will be marked off where all fuels must be held throughout the event and all refuelling must take place within this area.
 - 8- The starting procedure will be announced at the signing on.
 - 9- **No Practice riding before or after the event, anyone found to be doing so will be excluded from the event.**
 - 10- **No washing of machines of machines anywhere at the venue. Anyone found doing so will be excluded.**
 - 11- Personal Accident insurance is recommend for Ulster Centre License holders, riding in Ulster Centre events run under an Ulster Centre permit. Complete responsibility for effecting this cover lies with the competitor.
 - 12- **Please use the designated area for refuelling of bikes as indicated on the day.**
